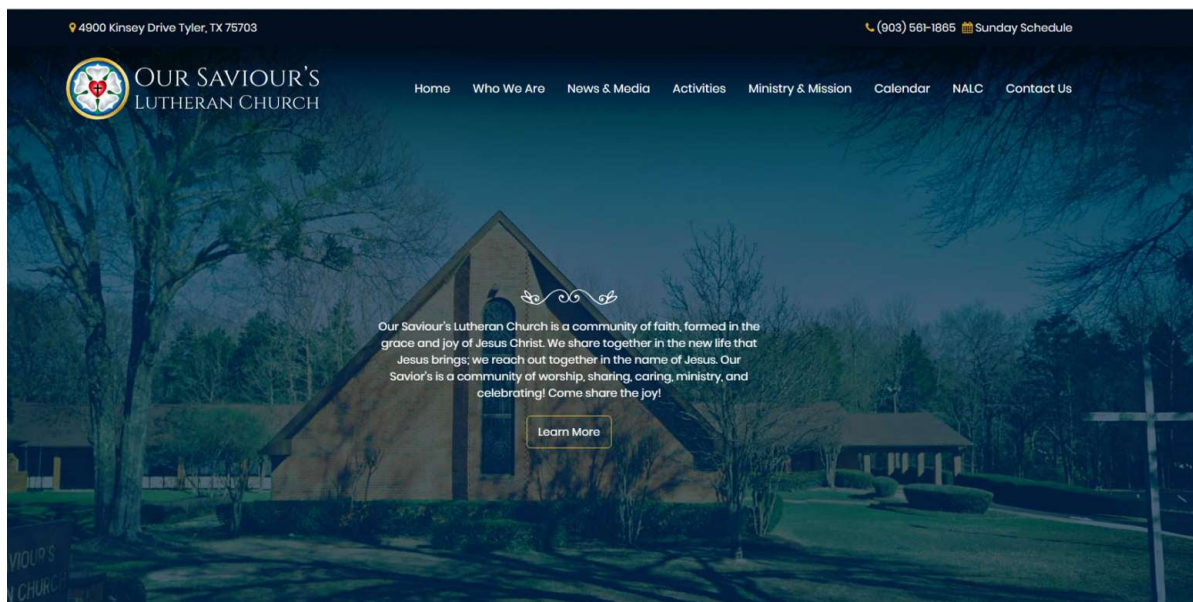
Shoe Box Drive

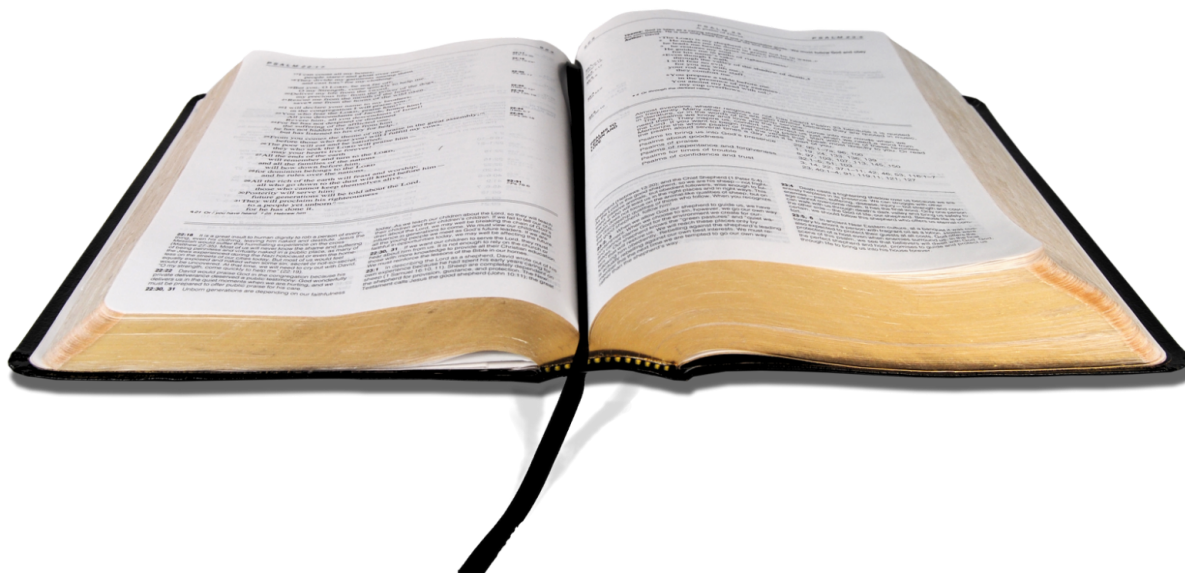
Polka Dance Lessons
