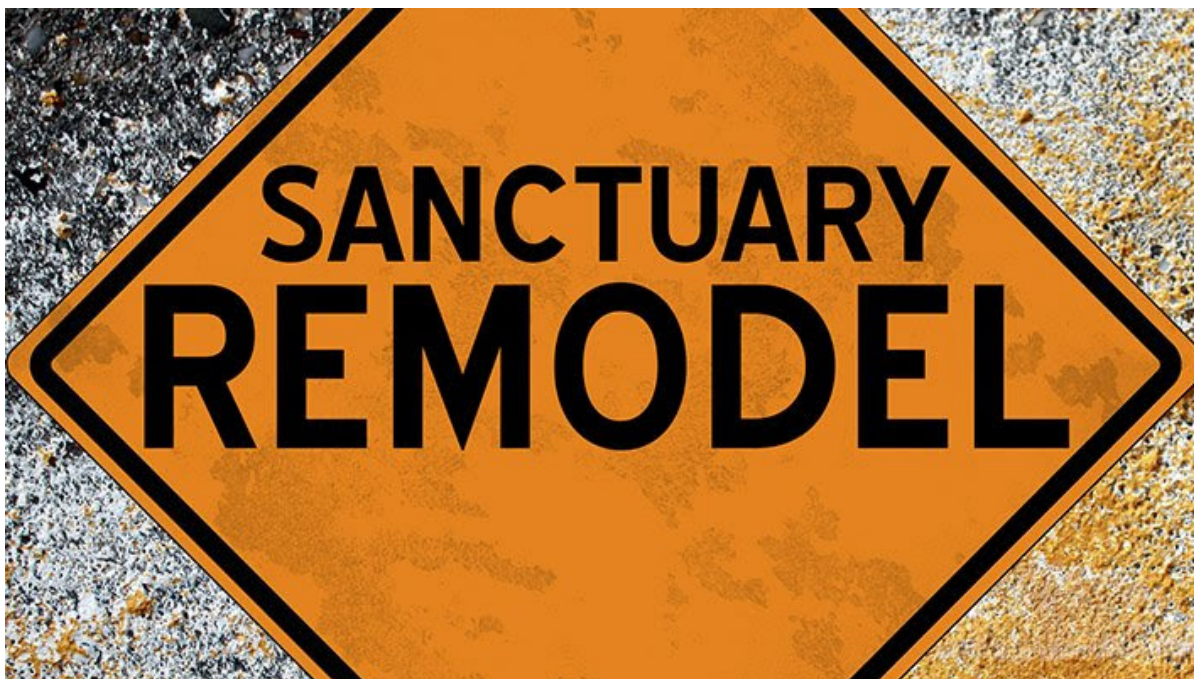
Last Day of Sunday School
