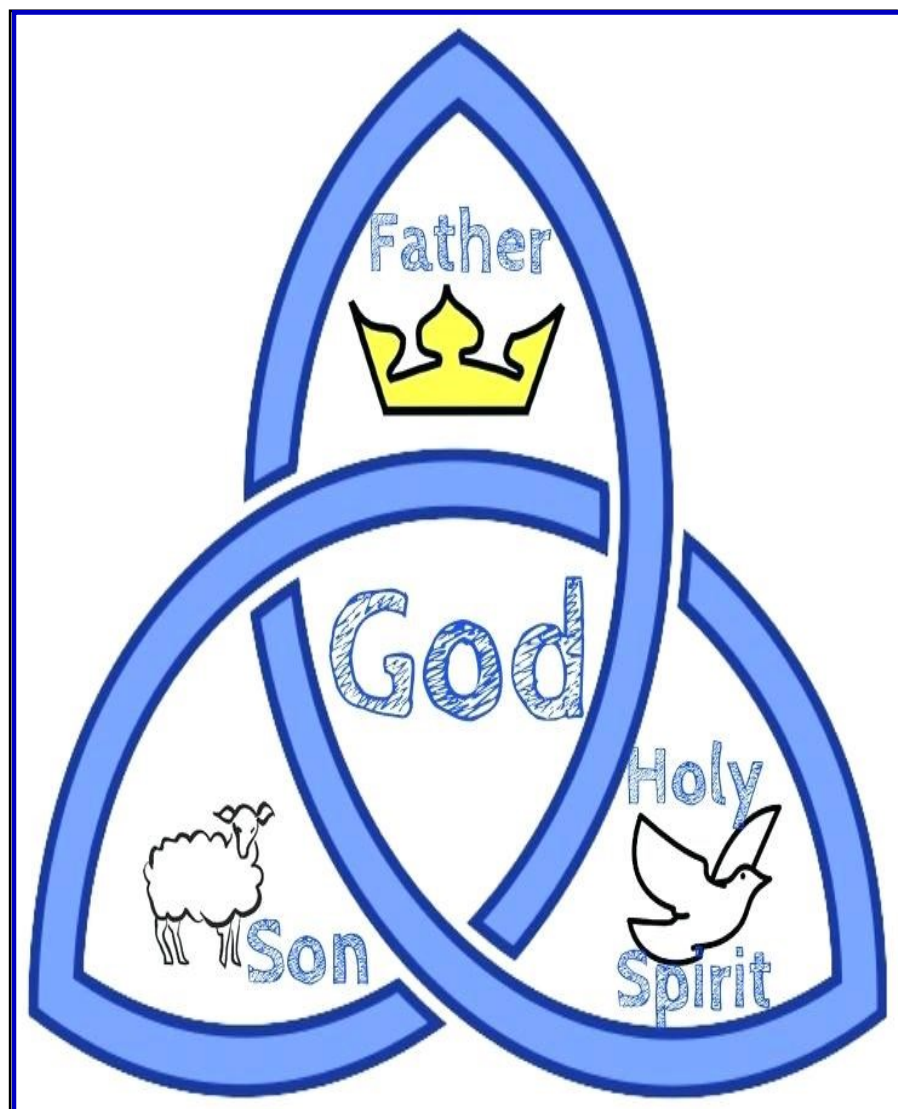

Administration's Office Hours

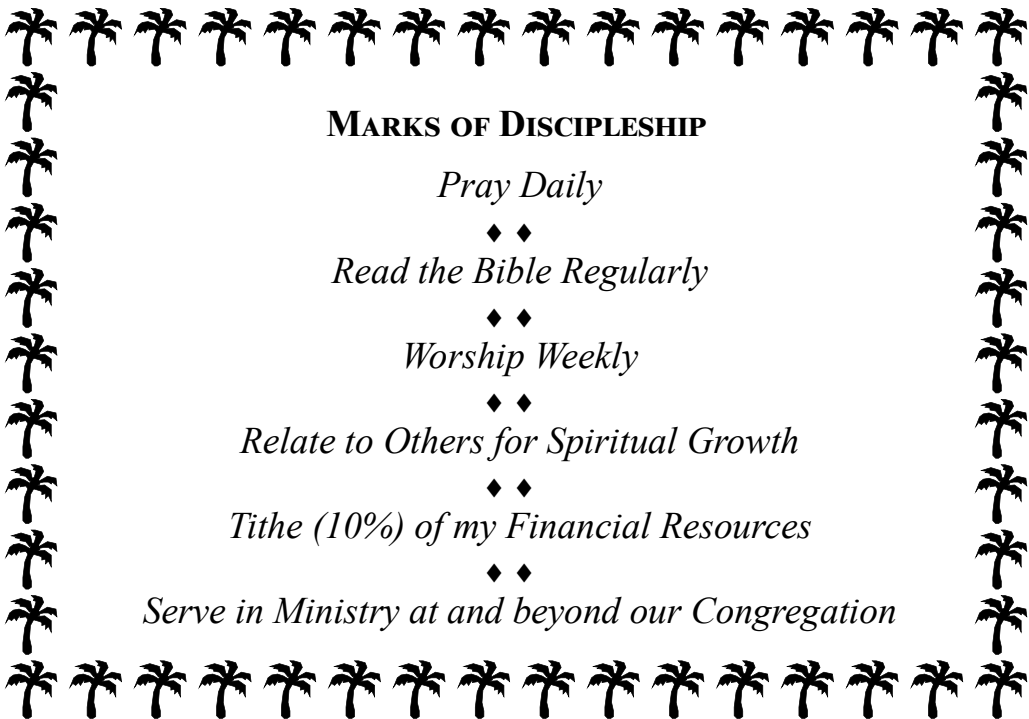
