Notice of Special Called Congregational Meeting

The City of Tyler is in the process of moving sewer lines that currently run within creek beds. One such sewer line is located on our property outside of our back fenced area. Tyler is planning to move the line out of the creek bed, but still on our property and still outside of our fenced area. This would involve OSLC allowing the movement of the current easement. The agreement specifies that no damage or crossing of our fenced area will be involved in the construction. Easter Egg Hunt

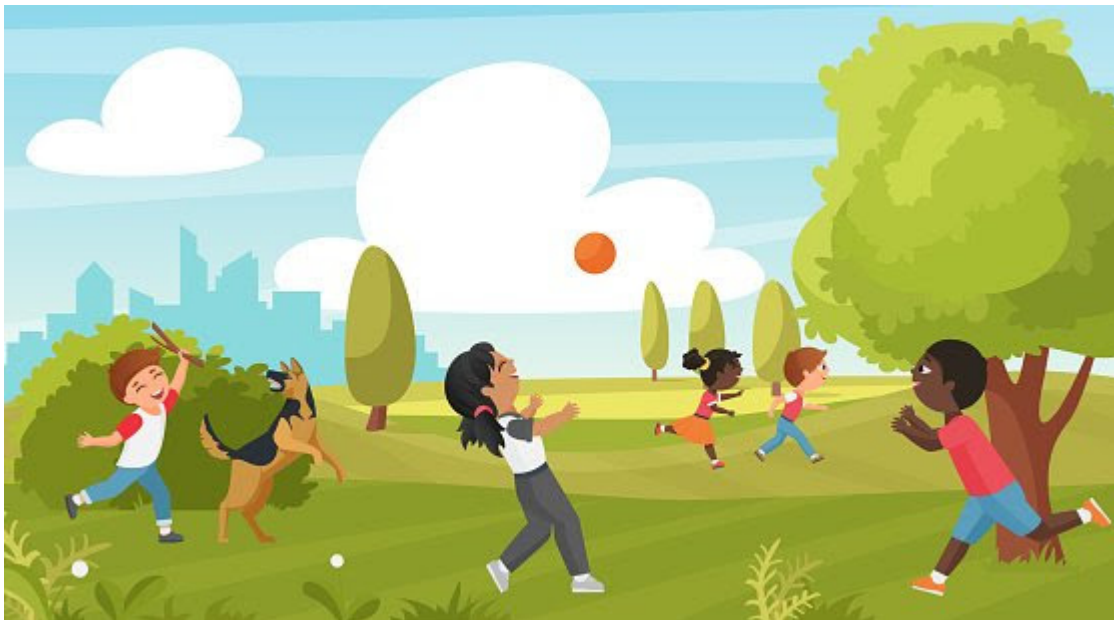

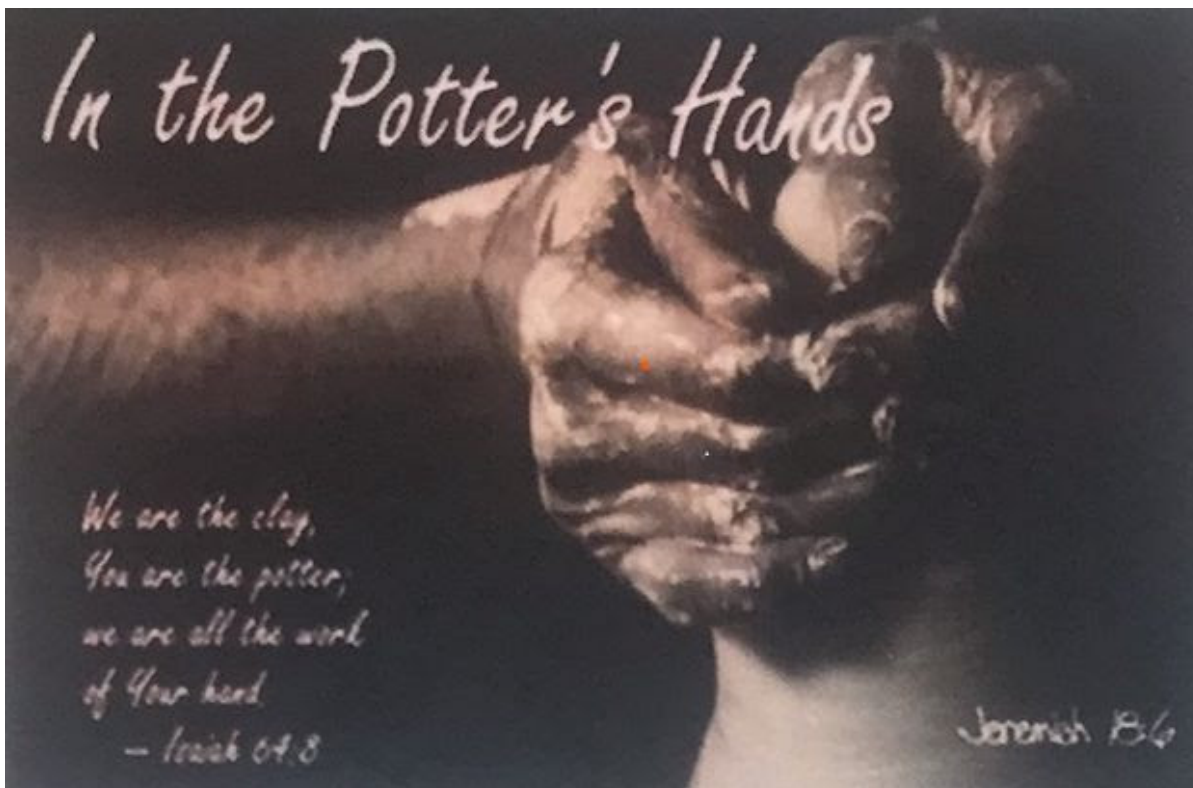
Youngn – completed 2nd or 3rd grade
