And after much debate about who has the best chili we will have a game of Andy Griffith Trivia pursuit. You have a generous two weeks to brush up on Andy and Barney.

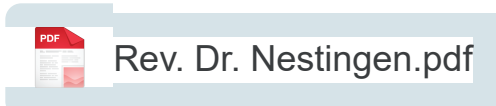
So, please join us on January 12th, bring a guest and let's have some fun!
