Last Sunday, March 26th, Clara and Elias Watkins were baptized. Colten and Heather are the proud parents.

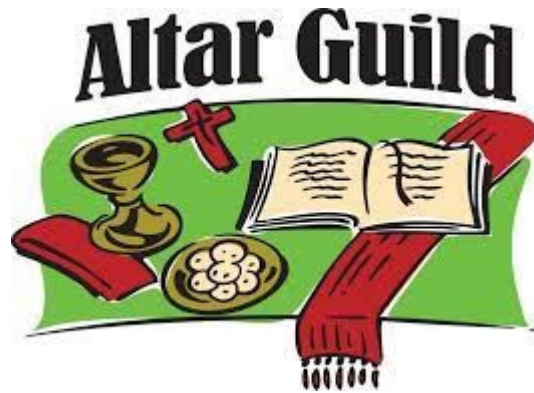
