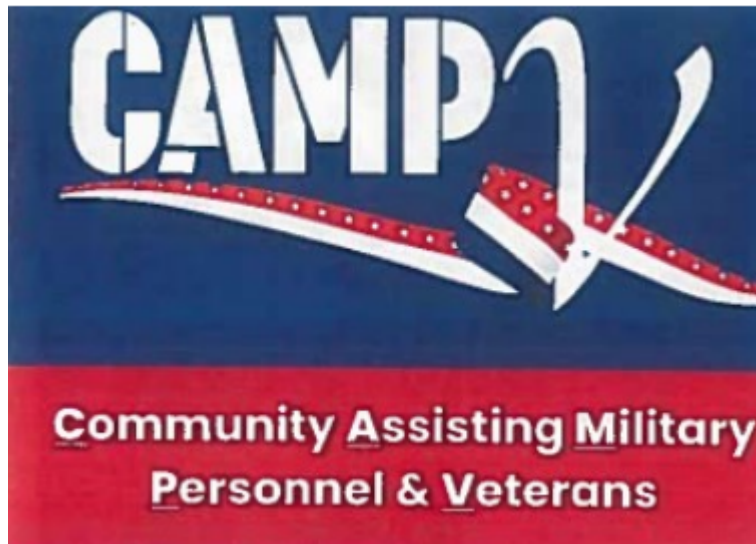

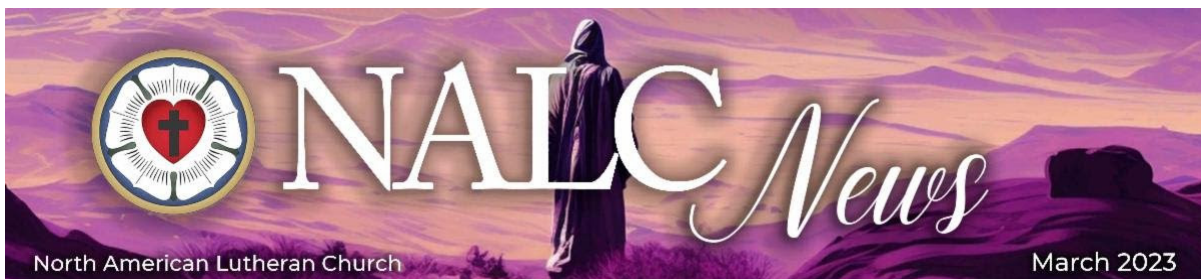


New Charity
