OSLC sent 109 Flood buckets, 87 Health Care kits, 28 School bags, 58 Brooms, 67 Quilts, and a few other odds & ends. In addition, Pastor Ricky Richards brought a pick-up load of supplies from Peace Lutheran, Clifton Tx to add to our relief supplies. He serves as the NTX/OK Disaster Relief Coordinator for our NALC Churches in this mission district. This load emptied our warehouse.

They were very appreciative to get our load of relief supplies. The need up there is great.

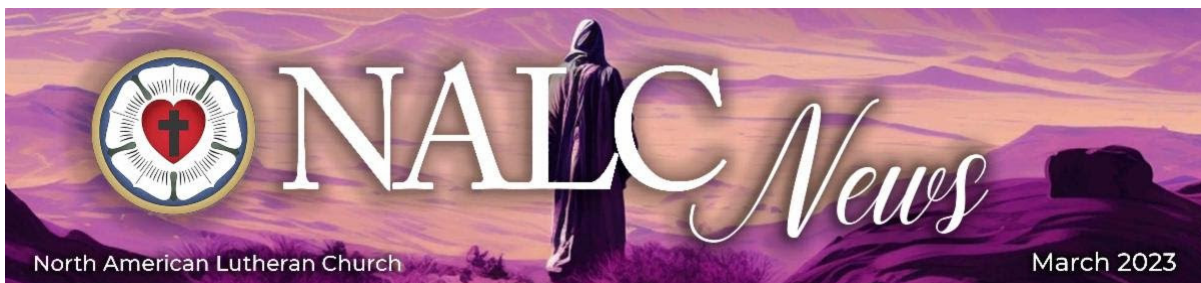
