OSLC Choir

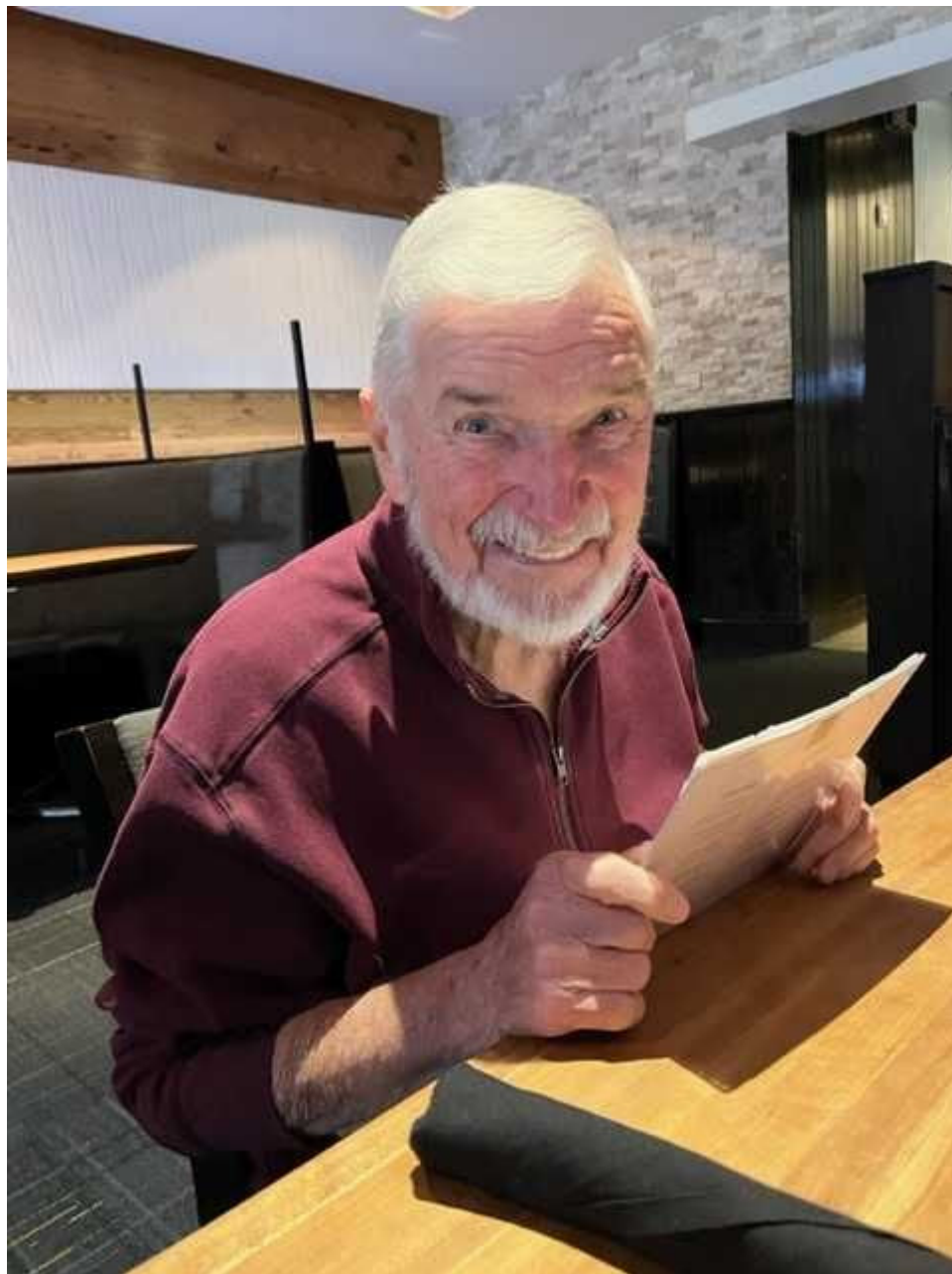
