Come join our celebration of Miss Curry's 90th birthday on Sunday, June 4th. Cake and coffee will be served after the church service.

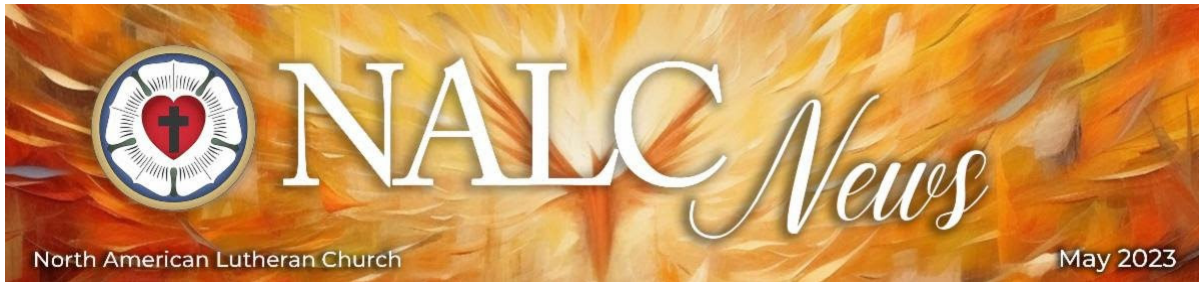


Congratulations Ben Snyder!
