

Special Congregational Meeting

We will be meeting next Sunday, November 5, following the service. The Church Council has reviewed OSLC Constitution and Bylaws and recommends changes designed to clean up formatting and other issues such as: consistent references to the "Church" Council vs. "Congregation," Council clarifies that only the congregation can make decisions involving "real" property and the Church Council can make decisions involving "personal" property; places responsibility on the Pastor to determine new membership qualifications and reporting same to the Church Council (currently Council approval has to be obtained prior to acceptance causing delays in membership); allows meeting notice to include email (while continuing to allow regular mail notice by those requesting it); clarifies that the Church Council selects OSLC voting representative(s) at National Convocation; clarifies that the Church Council consists of the pastor, officers, and 5 to 7 other members of the congregation; and extends by one month the time allowed by the Audit Committee to report audit results to the Church Council. The proposed changes are posted in the Narthex.
