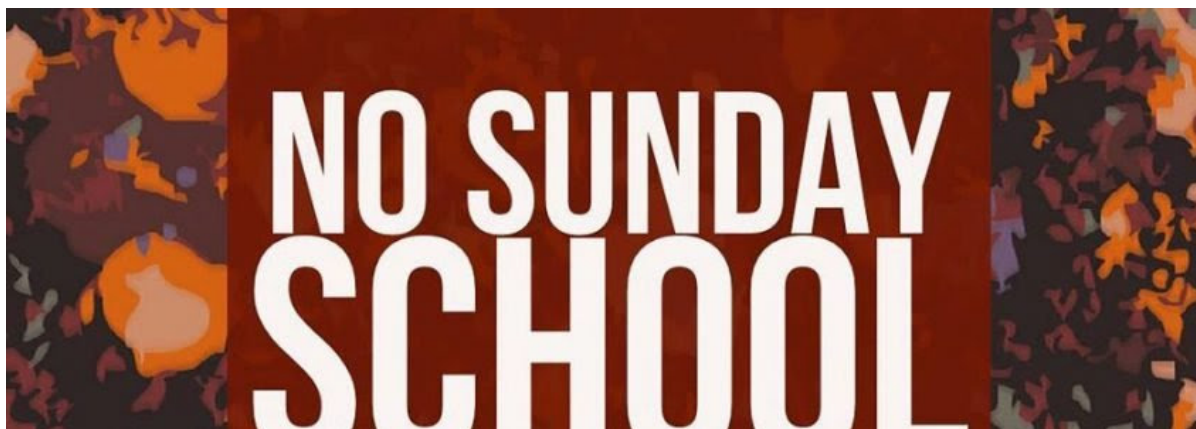

Prime Timers Friday, Dec 8th, Noon

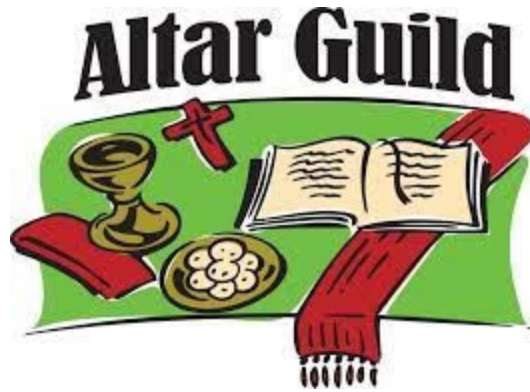
