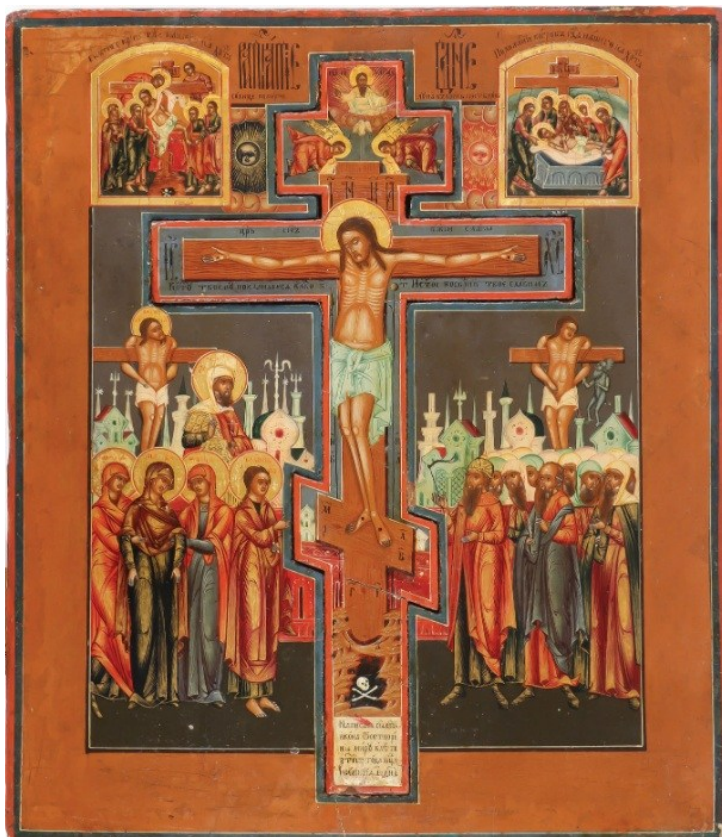

The Nicene Creed

THE GREAT THANKSGIVING ~ P. 88 LBW
