

DECLARATION OF OUR FAITH: THE APOSTLE'S CREED

P: St Paul writes: 1 Corinthians 12:4-7

⁴ Now there are varieties of gifts, but the same Spirit; ⁵ and there are varieties of service, but the same Lord; ⁶ and there are varieties of activities, but it is the same God who empowers them all in everyone. ⁷ To each is given the manifestation of the Spirit for the common good.

P: You have been elected to positions of leadership and trust in this congregation. You are to see that the words and actions of this household of faith reflect Jesus Christ our Lord, in whose name we gather. You are to work together with other members in council to see that the mission and ministry of Christ are done in this congregation, and that God's will is advanced in this community and in the whole world. You are to be diligent in your specific area of serving, that the one Lord who empowers you is glorified. You are to be examples of faithfulness and models of Christ to help maintain the life and harmony of this congregation.

P: On behalf of your sisters and brothers in Christ, I ask you: Are you ready to accept and faithfully to carry out the duties of the offices to which you have been elected?

Council each, in turn, answers: Yes, with the help of God.

P: People of God, I ask you: Will you support these, your elected leaders? Will you encourage them, pray for them, and assist them? Will you share in the mission and ministry that Christ has given to all who are baptized?

C: Yes, with the help of God

C: Gracious heavenly Father, pour Your Holy Spirit upon our Christian friends who are called to serve on Church Council.
